### Overview

Responsible for mechanical maintenance of USV diesel generators and other mechanical equipment during operations. This role will also provide key support for mobilising USVs including road transport and launch at project locations.

### Main Duties & Responsibilities

- Mechanical servicing of equipment including diesel generators to a very high standard.
- Maintenance of mechanical and electrical systems onsite.
- Compliance with execution and promotion of Quality, Health, Safety & Environment standards during all aspects of daily tasks.
- Participate/Lead in daily Toolbox talks.
- Installation of survey sensors to USVs prior to missions.
- Boarding support vessels to monitor USV movements near shore and in congested harbour areas.
- Planning and mobilisation of USVs for projects including road transport and launch at project locations.
- Provide local, on the ground, assessment of conditions and circumstances to aid project decisions.
- Monitoring site tooling and consumables levels.
- Implement, maintain, manage and update all standard operating procedures and processes appropriate to the role.

### On occasion this role may involve:

- Conducting general maintenance of USVs and trailers.
- Being responsible for training other team members to the required standards, including coaching and mentoring of others.

### Requirements: Essential Skills / Experience

- Minimum 5 years' expertise with diesel engines.
- Strong mechanical fitting ability.
- Significant industry experience in a similar role.
- Keen interest in marine activities.
- Hold full clean drivers' licence with BE licence minimum.

- Willing to travel.
- Capable of remote / independent operations with a heightened focus on safety.
- Computer literacy.
- Organised, Enthusiastic, positive, proactive and have a keen attention to detail.
- Ability to work to a very high standard.
- Ability to work on your own initiative and as part of a team.
