Overview

As we continue to grow our fleet and our scope of operations, there is a continuous need to develop the USVs to take advantage of advances in technology and knowledge. We have a significant and ongoing programme of Fleet Upgrades to support this development. The role of the Fleet Upgrade Project Manager is to manage that programme of work to ensure that we are maximising our resources to maintain our position at the forefront of uncrewed vessel engineering.

Main Duties & Responsibilities

Day to day activities will be varied, and will include:

- Driving progress of the range of Fleet Upgrade projects underway.
- Facilitate decisions on the prioritisation of projects by collating and presenting information on cost and benefit of various upgrades, and available resources.
- Managing test operations, including USV fitout and logistics for marine operations.
- Identifying opportunities for upgrades through consultation with internal stakeholders including reliability, operations, and commercial teams.
- Producing Upgrade Packages to instruct the production and maintenance teams in the incorporation of the upgrades to new and existing USVs.
