Overview

Responsible for build, maintenance and repair of all USV electronic components and equipment used in our vessels.

Main Duties & Responsibilities

- Electrical panel build & installation
- Conduct electrical maintenance on USVs
- Execution of FAT/SAT testing during commissioning
- Electrical design (power and communications)
- Compliance with, execution and promotion of Quality, Health and Safety standards on site at all times
- Managing and maintaining Quality, Environmental and Health & Safety standards
- Fault finding in mechanical and electrical systems
- Research & Development support on new USV technology

On occasion, this role may involve

- Accompanying USV offshore on support boat during testing
- Being responsible for generator servicing
- Conducting general mechanical maintenance of USV's
- Monitoring workshop tooling and consumables levels and purchasing same, with approval from Supervisor
- Implementing, maintaining, managing and updating all standard operating procedures and processes appropriate to the role.
- Being responsible for training other team members to the required standards, including coaching and mentoring of others

- Significant previous experience as an Electrical Technician
- Minimum 3 years' experience in Industrial/Control system wiring
- Hold full clean drivers' licence
